Dear RADIOMAG members,

In August 2017, the COST office upgraded our RADIOMAG budget and provided us with a new networking tool, *i.e.* the ITC conference grants.

Inclusiveness Target Country (ITC) conference grants are aimed at supporting PhD students and Early Career Investigators (ECI)\* from participating ITCs to attend international science and technology related conferences not specifically organised by RADIOMAG.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

- 1. Conference Grants are exclusively reserved for PhD students and ECIs with a primary affiliation in an institution located in an ITC.
- 2. The applicant must make an oral/poster presentation at the conference in question and must be listed in the official event/conference programme. The main subject of the oral presentation / poster presentation / speech at the approved conference must be on the topic of the Action and must acknowledge COST.
- 3. The participation of each applicant must be pre-approved by the Action MC. Attendance at European conferences is preferred. However, conferences held elsewhere can also be considered.

<sup>\*</sup> Early Career Investigators (ECI): a researcher whose career spun less than 8 years between the date of the PhD/doctorate (or similar experience) and the date of involvement in the <u>COST Action</u>. Periods of career leave have to be added to this time span.

The deadline for applications is **26**<sup>th</sup> of **November 2017**, the candidates will be informed until 30<sup>th</sup> of November 2017. The selection of successful applicants will be done under consideration of the scientific scope of the proposed mission and how the mission can support the Action in achieving its scientific objectives.
