Information & Call fiche for ITC conference grants

Dear RADIOMAG members,

Inclusiveness Target Country (ITC) conference grants are aimed at supporting PhD students and Early Career Investigators (ECI)* from participating ITCs to attend international science and technology related conferences not specifically organised by RADIOMAG.

In the new Grant Period starting from 1st of May 2018 and lasting until 12th of November 2018, five ITC conference grants up to 2000 € each will be again available.

PhD students and ESRs from ITCs who perform a STSM previously in RADIOMAG are particularly encouraged to apply for an ITC Grant to present their results at a conference. Interested ITC PhD students and ESRs are invited to fill the web-application form given here below.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Conference Grants are <u>exclusively reserved for PhD students and ECIs</u> with a primary affiliation in an institution located <u>in an ITC</u>, i.e. Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Croatia, Hungary, Lithuania, Latvia, Luxembourg, Malta, Montenegro, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Republic of Serbia and Turkey.
- 2. The applicant <u>must give an oral/poster presentation</u> at the conference in question and must be <u>listed in</u> <u>the official event/conference programme</u>. The main subject of the oral presentation / poster presentation / speech at the approved conference must be within the frame RADIOMG and must acknowledge COST.
- 3. The participation of each applicant must be pre-approved by the Action MC. Attendance at European conferences is preferred. However, conferences held elsewhere can also be considered.

^{*} Early Career Investigators (ECI): a researcher whose career spun less than 8 years between the date of the PhD/doctorate (or similar experience) and the date of involvement in the COST Action. Periods of career leave have to be added to this time span.

The non-extendable deadline for applications is **20**th of June **2018**, the candidates will be informed until 25th of June 2018. The selection of successful applicants will be done under consideration of the scientific scope of the proposed mission and how the mission can support the Action in achieving its scientific objectives.
